Re: BUSTR 5-year rules review

Thank you in advance for your help with our five-year rule review. BUSTR has developed desired changes to the Ohio Administrative Code and will be presenting them to the regulated community over the next few months. Your workgroup will focus on rules related to environmental protection, specifically the following:

- Ohio Administrative Code Rule 1301:7-9-12, Temporarily Out of Service, Temporarily Closed, Permanent Abandonment, Permanent Removal, Replacement and Change in Service of UST Systems.
- Ohio Administrative Code Rule 1301:7-9-13, Petroleum UST Corrective Action
- Ohio Administrative Code Rule 1301:7-9-16, Petroleum Contaminated Soils
- Ohio Administrative Code Rule 1301:7-9-17, Sampling and Analysis of Excavated Soils for Purposes of Treatment

The purpose of this workgroup is to advise the BUSTR Chief on how the rules will be received by the regulated community, note any objections to agency goals or propose alternate ways to achieve those goals, and provide assistance in rule drafting, fiscal analysis, and technical support if requested.

Our first meeting is scheduled for 10 AM, July 10th, at the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Room 130. The purpose of the July 10th meeting is for BUSTR to present agency goals and proposed rule changes, hear initial feedback, and to schedule future follow-up meetings as necessary.

Proposed rule changes and executive summaries are attached. Please note that a version of Rule 13, Petroleum UST Corrective Action is not yet available in a format clearly illustrating stricken and newly added passages, but that such a version will be made available to you on the 10th. A map showing how to reach the Office of the State Fire Marshal is also enclosed.
